

2011 "ALDERDALE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Carefully selected, blended, and barrel aged for 24 months this Estate Grown Cabernet Sauvignon is clean and youthful, with an alluring combination of sweet black currant and boysenberry flavors dominating the highly perfumed nose. The dense bouquet is absolutely loaded and is further lifted by heady scents of lavender and violets, sweet spice, eucalyptus, and cedar. Full bodied with concentrated dark fruit flavors of black cherry, mocha, ripe plum and hints of nutmeg and clove. The wine is dry but has a juicy freshness supported by savory earth characteristics that gradually take a backseat to a more muscular mid-palate, which helps display its true new world roots. There's noteworthy intensity and focus to that mid-palate, before the structure really amps up in the finish. With outstanding length and pervasive minerality, there is no shortage of potential with the 2011. Give it a long decant if drinking before 2015 or with proper cellaring, it will show its whole spectrum of flavors.
