

Also known as Blau Frankisch in Austria, this rich, fruit forward red is deep in color, showcasing a beautiful bouquet full of blueberries, blackberries, plum, and hints of cedar and spice. Lemberger is relatively rare in Washington State and the grapes for this bottling were hand selected from our Estate Vineyard, Destiny Ridge, where it then receives limited aging in French Oak to express and protect the gorgeous fruit profile and terrior of this fantastic vineyard site. Medium in body, this young, lively red is bright and balanced with its judicious amount of acidity weaving effortlessly though the lengthy finish. That lengthy finish is framed and supported by a full flavor profile of wild black currants, marionberry, rose petal and hints of dried herb. Pairs well with beef or lamb, and while impressive now, feel free to bottle age another year or so to let this young wine fully integrate.
