2013 "BIG SHOT" TEMPRANILLO

Washington State grown Tempranillo's might be rare, but they continue to display a New World style that is beautifully bold and racy. Deep red and garnet in color, a generous bouquet of buttery toffee, fresh strawberry pie, and mocha mingle with the tangy aromas of cassis and boysenberry. Medium to full bodied, with excellent concentration throughout the palate, the black cherry and black currant flavors are juicy and rich and are pleasantly invigorated by the bright acidity and floral qualities of the ripe fruit flavors. The supple finish is vibrant, long, strong, and well integrated with silky tannins and the lighter styled oaked backing. Feel free to decant this lovely red now or give it another year or two in the bottle to soften and further unite. Drink now through 2019.
