Our Estate Grown Petit Verdot offers a wealth of concentrated power that holds true to its name, a vast amount of blackberry that leads to a jammy and robustly ripe, dark flavors of licorice, leather, tobacco, with dried tea to round out the savory character. Finishing with lively acids and well integrated tannins. Don't be misled by his name; "Little Big Man" is a big and bold wine, with a bright and precise acidity, the mouthwatering tannins run the length of the palate. Enjoy this robust wine on its own or with a hearty steak, grilled meats, spicy pork, veal, lamb, game birds, an artisan sausage with good fat content, or pork belly. This is also a versatile cheese wine. While it is drinking well now, this wine will only benefit from some cellaring time. If consuming prior to 2017, please decant.
