

2015 "A Squared" Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

The 2015 growing season was one of the hottest on record for Washington State. Hot, dry weather with reprieve from the heat at opportune moments provided ideal conditions for the harvest. The effect of the weather pattern is present in the wines which show a fusion of power and elegance. A combination of heat and the dramatic shift in night time temperature at Destiny Ridge allowed the grapes to reach their full potential of ripeness, while retaining just the right amount of acidity to bring the wines to life. With an exquisite supply of well-integrated tannin, and stunning aromatics of blueberry, blackberry, and black currant, this wine is brought full circle via its nuanced oak profile of vanilla, cedar box and cocoa. This is a wine consisting of layers upon layers of flavor and complexity with dark cherry, blackberry, tobacco, and toasted brown sugar. The palate is structured, lively and rewarding, showcasing the symmetry of fruit, oak and acidity present throughout the wine. Although made to drink upon release, this wine has the potential to cellar for 5 to 7 years.
