TASTING NOTES

This absolute monster of a wine lives up to its name. The nose is an intense blend of rich blackberry reduction, black raspberry, licorice, smoked meat, and leather. The palate shows firm, ripe tannins which are complemented by a heavy dose of blackberry, plum, star anise, sarsaparilla, and smoky tobacco... damn delicious. A true Petite Sirah, it begs to be paired with barbecued meats, full-flavored and smoked cheeses, smoked game, wild mushroom risotto, bratwurst, or your favorite full-bodied cigar. Don't forget to decant!

VINTAGE

The 2018 vintage started out warmer than usual but ended up delivering a kind growing season. By June the weather was nice, and then it got hot through July and most of August. This vintage really benefited from September and October with warm days and cool nights allowing the fruit to mature nicely.
