TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Alderdale Cabernet, picked from our esteemed hillside Block 5, is sure to please the crowd. Beautifully rich in color, this wine opens up with sweet aromatics of freshly picked blackberries, black cherry, currant, earth, and a slight floral undertone. The palate is full of fresh red cherry, raspberry, juicy plum, and savory herbs. The powerful dusty tannins are going to help this wine age beautifully and show its true potential in another 7-10 years. Enjoy with a big, rich piece of beef fresh off the grill.

VINTAGE

The 2019 vintage started with a late winter with several days of below-average temperatures in June. Heat units rose throughout the early summer providing an optimal window to ripen our cherished white varietals. An abnormal early frost of freezing temperatures throughout Eastern Washington made this vintage one to remember.
